- **\*MATCH PLAY** will be played Mon/Tue/Wed. with a 1:00 PM starting time on Monday. There will be 18 hole matches with seeded 8 man flights set by USGA index. Monday first round losers will be in consolation flights starting Tuesday. Second round championship, third place and consolation winners will play final matches Wednesday morning while those losing twice have the option of playing a third round in an all-flight net event on Wednesday morning. Entry fee includes dinner on Monday evening and lunch on Tuesday after your matches. Tee selection allowed with course handicaps adjusted accordingly.
- **\*\*STATE TOURNAMENT** will be played Tue/Wed/Thu. Entry fee includes golf, cart, range balls, trophy & gift certificate awards, skins and meals following the golf on Tuesday & Wednesday. All 3 days will be played on the Sundance course. The A-Ga-Ming Resort will be the tournament host facility with preferred lodging rates. All players will be in net competition. Tee selection allowed, but only Seniors (Ages 50 & up) playing back tees, Super-Seniors (age 65 & up) playing middle tees and Legends (ages 70 & up) playing forward tees will be eligible for the 3 age-based gross competitions. State Tournament limited to 108 participants.
